INSTRUCTION SHEET

Dear Dunsmuir Scholarship Fund Applicant:

The Board of Directors of the Dunsmuir Scholarship Fund (DSF) plans to award a sizeable amount in scholarships this year. Several awards have unique requirements; such as the Rose A. Ellis Scholarship to be awarded to a DHS graduating Senior intending to pursue a course of study at the College of the Siskiyou.

If your application is to be considered by the Committee, you must attach the following in order:

- 1) A properly completed and appropriately signed application (Include page 2, and 3 of this packet); AND, the following items. (Please note: Extra information and enclosures additional to that listed below will NOT be reviewed.);
- 2) A typewritten one page essay describing your plans for future education; i.e. school of your choice, major, occupational goals, and any other pertinent information;
- 3) One completed "Activities Sheet" (page 4 of this packet);
- 4) Reference letters from:
 - a) ONE high school administration or faculty member;
 - b) ONE other adult (a community member not affiliated with the high school);
- 5) A sealed official high school transcript reflecting a GPA of not less than 2.50 for the first 7 semesters of high school. This GPA will be verified by the DHS Guidance Director.

DEADLINE: Current graduate applications are ONLY ACCEPTED BY MAIL, and must be postmarked no later than April 15th. For your protection, you should purchase a "Certificate Of Mailing" when you mail your application. If the Committee asks you to verify the date that you mailed the application, you must have the "Certificate Of Mailing" to present to them. Return your completed application to:
